

Bachelor of Science in Aviation Maintenance (BSAM)

- Commencement : July 2010
- Places available : 50
- Course duration : A minimum of 3 years, up to a maximum of 8 years
- Programme content : The programme will focus on the technical competency training and cross disciplinary skills in aviation maintenance with a specialised Boeing 737 New Generation Line Type 2 certification course. The programme will also include soft skills on aviation administration and management.
- Course fees : About S\$60,000 (before prevailing government taxes and subsidies from the Ministry of Education (MOE) and WDA)
- Entry Requirements : Applicants will be considered for admission if they meet the following minimum eligibility criteria of UniSIM:
- For programme with MOE subsidy, applicants must satisfy the following criteria:
- 1) Two years of work experience or in full-time employment; and
 - 2) 21 years old and above; and
 - 3) Possess a minimum of 2 GCE 'A' level passes or its equivalent or an approved professional Diploma or equivalent qualification from a recognised institution.
- For programme without MOE subsidy, applicants must satisfy the following criteria:
- 1) Possess a minimum of 2 GCE 'A' level passes or its equivalent or an approved professional Diploma or equivalent qualification from a recognized institution.

- Places available : 50
- Course duration : A minimum of 3 years, up to a maximum of 8 years
- Programme content : The programme will focus on aviation business administration and management, covering areas such as economics, aeronautical science, aviation business statistics & accounting, aviation business marketing and management and international business.
- Course fees : About S\$60,000
(before prevailing government taxes and subsidies from MOE and WDA)
- Entry Requirements : Applicants will be considered for admission if they meet the following minimum eligibility criteria of UniSIM:
- For programme with MOE subsidy, applicants must satisfy the following criteria:
- 1) Two years of work experience or in full-time employment; and
 - 2) 21 years old and above; and
 - 3) Possess a minimum of 2 GCE 'A' level passes or its equivalent or an approved professional Diploma or equivalent qualification from a recognised institution.
