Mrs Goh is the President & CEO of ST Asset Management Ltd and Director of ST Trustees Ltd.

Mrs Goh has over 20 years of extensive experience in managing fund management companies which invest in the full spectrum of financial instruments ranging from public equities, bonds, loans, asset backed securities, currencies to alternative investments such as private equity, hedge funds, derivatives and commodities.

Prior to joining ST Asset Management Ltd in 2002, Mrs Goh spent 11 years with the Overseas Union Bank Limited Group. Under her leadership as CEO & Executive Director of OUB Asset Management Ltd (OUBAM), assets under management grew from S\$400 million in 1990 to S\$5.6 billion in April 2002, making OUBAM the largest bank-backed fund management firm in Singapore then. During the period 1999 to 2002, OUBAM and its affiliates also won numerous investment awards locally and internationally for the retail unit trusts they managed.

Before joining OUB, Mrs Goh was a director of M&A Investments Pte Ltd, which is an investment holding company, with primary responsibility of taking substantial equity stakes in listed companies. In addition, she participated in a leverage buy-out of a US company. From 1983 to 1989, she worked for Sembawang Holdings Ltd and was responsible for project financing in offshore oil and gas engineering projects, hedging the group's foreign exchange exposure and the management of equity, fixed income and property investments. From 1979 to 1983, she worked in an international audit firm, a Singapore government statutory board and an Asian-based information technology company.

Since January 2002, Mrs Goh has been a member of the Panel of Experts for Securities Offences, Commercial Affairs Department, Singapore.

Mrs Goh serves as a member of Singapore Corporation of Rehabilitative Enterprises (SCORE) since November 2004. She also chairs SCORE's Investment & Finance Committee since February 2004 and is a member of its Tender Approving Committee. Her other appointments include being a member of the Investment Committees of the National Kidney Foundation and the Singapore Chinese Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

Previously she held directorship in Singapore Consortium Investment Management Ltd and was a member of the Executive Committee of Investment Management Association of Singapore and a member of the Investor Education Advisory Committee of Securities Investors Association (Singapore).

Mrs Goh holds a Bachelor of Accountancy (2nd Class Honours) from the former University of Singapore, a Masters of Business Administration from the National University of Singapore and a Masters of Science (Business) from the Nanyang Technological University of Singapore. She is also a member of CFA Institute and has been conferred the title of Financial Industry Certified Professional.
